MEETING MINUTES

Village President Harley Cochran called the 2022 Village of Stockholm caucus to order at 5:30 pm.

Jerry Larson, Dennis Riechert, David Hanson and Tracy Tabery-Weller were voted to be on the ballot should they accept their nominations.

John Krumm moved to adjourn the caucus, 2nd by Jerry Larson. Caucus Adjourned.

Village President Harley Cochran opened the regular Board meeting and roll call was taken. Those present and online were Harley Cochran, John Krumm, Jerry Larson, Kristin Smith-Proctor, Heidi Krause, C/T.

Clerk's Report: The December 14, 2021 minutes were sent out. Motion by Jerry, 2nd by John to accept the Clerk's Report; carried.

Treasurer's Report: There were issues in getting it printed. Report will be given in February for both December and January.

Park Committee Report: We had some ice fisherman staying at the park. Will be discussed at next park committee meeting. Dennis Riechert volunteered to take care of shutting off remaining electricity in park.

Zoning Administrator Report: No report.

Planning Commission Report: No report.

Premier Resort Area Tax (PRAT) Committee Report: No report.

New Business:

1. New Zoning Administrator Roy Forrstrom was introduced. He shared his history and background.
2. Discussion of amending cemetery regulations to include green burial. It will be added to the agenda in February to give trustees time to review the information.
3. Smartgrowth: Social cultural aspects have been impacted by COVID. Looking into having more community events this summer depending on conditions. Solar initiatives, walking paths, and archeological survey of the cemetery are some things to think about.

4. Tourism Grant: The Tourism Grant awards will be announced sometime in December. Still haven't heard anything yet.
5. Covid 19 grant – no new updates. Possibility of Emergency Declaration from Windstorm...consensus was that it would not be prudent as damage was minor in the village. John Krumm will coordinate with Harley to contact Wabasha Tree Service to remove branches on street behind the church. Residents have expressed interest in the firewood.

6. \$1200 snow removal relief from PRAT funds to aid businesses in snow removal. Tabled to February so that dispersal plan can be included as to what it entails. Reminder, it is the property owner's primary responsibility for removal of snow. The village takes no responsibility.
7. Citizen Concerns: We will not have a need for a Primary Election in February. Spring Election will be April 6, 2022. Move of the copier and file cabinets went well. Thank you to Ted Fenstermacher, Cindy Fayerweather, Harley Cochran, Dan Heitman, Angie Amundson, Scott Krause and Heidi Krause for helping make it happen.
8. The next Village Board meeting will be held at 6:00 PM on February 8th, 2022.
9. No other action taken by the Board. A motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Jerry, 2nd by Kristin. Motion carried, meeting adjourned.
